

Games for sight words

1. My pile your pile

Have the pile of sight word cards face down. Take the first card from the top of the pile and show your child. If they instantly recognise it then they get to keep it, if not you keep it. The winner of the game is the person with the most cards.

2. Memory

Make a duplicate pack of sight word cards so there is maybe 12 altogether. Place them all face down take turns to pick to cards. If they match (and they can read the word) then they get to keep the cards. The winner is the person with the most pairs.

3. Treasure chest

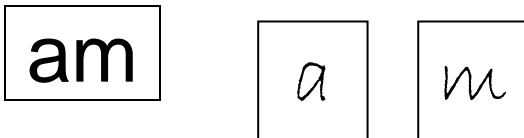
Make up a simple treasure chest or something similar that interests your child. Every time they read a sight word instantly they get to post it into their 'treasure chest'.

4. Word Search

Make a simple word search containing sight words to be learnt. Can they find the words and circle them?

5. Make it

Make up a chart like below. Have each word made up on a separate card where they have to 'find it' and place in the corresponding column. Then the letters of the word on separate cards so they have to 'make it', place them in the corresponding column. Then they write it.
