Kawhia has been working hard over the last few weeks to dazzle as our stars during our kei hea nga whetu? Production!


Room 3 and 4's star Hiwa-i-te-rangi is a wishing star used to grant wishes and aspirations for the year ahead.

We looked at what different constellations look like and then had a go designing our own using marshmallows and toothpicks.


